Q What are the three most common issues found on home inspections?

A TERMITES: They are common on Long Island, many houses have them or have had them. The trick is to find them and the signs are not always clear and a good inspection is needed. MOLD: mold in a basement or attic. Once we understand why you have it and what needs to be done to keep it from coming back it can be corrected properly. WATER SEEPAGE into basements. Understanding where it is coming from and from there we can determine the best corrective action.

Q How does the inspection process differ from new construction to resale?

A The biggest difference here is understanding how a house functions. Knowing if a system is correctly installed and what could occur in the future if it is left to run or vent incorrectly. This could save a great deal of money in the future.

Q What is the biggest problem with the inspection of a pool?
